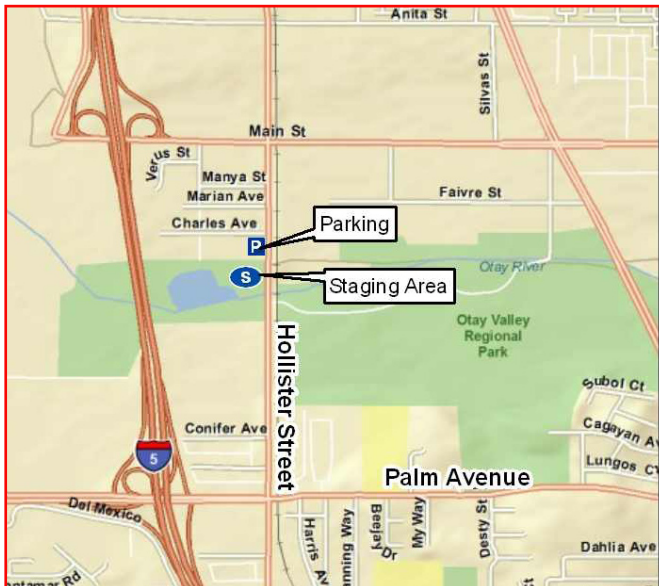


# JOIN US FOR THE RIBBON CUTTING FOR STAGE II OF OTAY VALLEY REGIONAL PARK TRAILS
